Seminar Club Guidelines for Ph.D. Scholars, July 2018

1. The presentation is mandatory for each Ph.D. student, and a minimum of 70% of seminar attendance would be essential for attending conferences, workshops, and symposiums by JRF/SRF/RA/Project Fellows.
2. Each student has to give journal presentation completing one year of research and work presentation after completing two years.
3. The session will start from 1st week of March every year and will continue until last week of January next year.
4. The seminar will start at 9.30 AM SHARP every Tuesday. It will begin with a journal presentation followed by work presentation as per the schedule.
5. Each student will present a journal presentation (20+5 min) and work presentation (30 +10 min.) as per the schedule.
6. There will be a separate day/date for the guest seminar and other seminars without disturbing the student seminar schedule. In a case, a student leaves the institute in the middle of the session; rest of the seminars will prepone accordingly.
7. Students are advised to present the work done by them in the last one year; however, they can include previous works in the introduction section.
8. Students are encouraged to present a research article (not a review article), published in the last 1-2 years of their own choice but not related to their area of research. Advised to limit the journal presentation to 10-15 slides.
9. Students are advised to submit the title and abstract of their work presentation/ title of journal presentation along with PDF copy of paper at least one week before the scheduled date for e-mail circulation.
10. The research work done by the student, individually or in collaboration, will only be considered for the presentation.
11. The student is not allowed to cancel or postpone the seminar.
12. The scientists attending the seminar will evaluate the work presented. Students attending the seminar may continue to assess the Journal presentation. The final score will be calculated considering 75% weightage for seminar + 25% weightage for attendance.
13. Each year, there will be three awards for best work presentations, and also for Journal presentation.
14. A final report (Attendance/Marks/Awardees) will be submitted to the Director by the end of the session for approval.
15. Attendance of latecomers/early leavers will not be considered.
