- o The paper will include sections on:
 - a) General Knowledge / General Aptitude 20 Question/Marks
 - b) Government of India Rules & Guidelines 20 Question/Marks
 - c) Diploma-level Questions in Civil Engineering 20 Question/Marks
 - d) Diploma-level Questions in Electrical Engineering 20 Question/Marks
 - e) B.Sc. / DMLT Subject Questions 20 Question/Marks

Each question will carry one mark and there is no negative mark.

- 4. **Prohibited Items**: Mobile phones, smart watches, electronic devices, study materials, and calculators are strictly prohibited inside the exam hall.
- 5. General Instructions:
 - o No TA/DA will be paid for attending the written examination.
 - o Canvassing in any form will lead to disqualification.
