**INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES**

- 1. Provisional Admission:** The Hall Ticket is purely provisional. If any ineligibility is detected at any stage or if any information provided by the candidate is found incorrect, the candidature will be cancelled without notice.
- 2. Documents to Bring:** Candidates must bring the following to the examination centre:
  - Original Hall Ticket (duly filled and signed)
  - Original and photocopy of a valid Photo ID proof containing clear photograph and signature.Acceptable ID Proofs: Voter ID / Aadhaar / Driving Licence / Passport / Bank Passbook with Photograph.  
No other ID proof will be accepted.
- 3. Error Correction:** Any error in the Hall Ticket should be reported in writing to The Director, BRIC-ILS, Bhubaneswar on the day of examination (02.11.2025, Sunday).
- 4. Reporting & Exam Schedule:** Reporting Time for Document Verification: **9:00 AM**  
Entry closes at: 9:45 AM  
Examination Timing: 10:45 AM – 12:15 PM  
Latecomers will not be permitted.
- 5. Prohibited Items:** Candidates must not carry printed materials or electronic gadgets (mobiles, smart watches, calculators, etc.). Only the Hall Ticket, ID proof, and photocopy of ID are allowed. No arrangement for safekeeping of personal items will be provided.
- 6. OMR Sheet Instructions:** Enter Roll Number correctly. Darken the appropriate circles neatly. Sign in the designated box on the OMR sheet.
- 7. Attendance Sheet:** Candidates must enter the Answer Sheet Serial Number and Question Booklet Code, write Contact/Mobile Number, sign against Roll Number, and affix Left-Hand Index Finger Impression.
- 8. Question Paper Pattern:** 100 Objective Type (MCQ) questions covering the entire syllabus. Each question carries 1 mark.
- 9. Answering Guidelines:** Mark only one correct option per question. Multiple answers = Incorrect. No marks for unanswered questions.

**10. During Examination:** Do not give or obtain assistance of any kind. No candidate shall leave the hall between 10:45 AM – 12:15 PM.

**11. Unfair Means:** Copying, note-taking, or removing question paper pages is strictly prohibited and will lead to cancellation of candidature.

**12. OMR Sheet Care:** Avoid stray marks, folds, or smudges. Only one OMR sheet will be issued. Improper marking may invalidate the response.

**13. Preserve Hall Ticket:** The Candidate's Copy of the Hall Ticket must be retained and produced at the time of joining, if selected.

**14. After Examination:** Before leaving, hand over the following to the Invigilator:

- Signed Question Paper (all pages)
- OMR Sheet
- Signed photocopy of ID Proof
- Invigilator's Copy of Hall Ticket (bottom portion)

**15. Tie-Break Criteria:** In case of equal marks, merit will be decided as follows:

- a) Higher marks in – Computer Knowledge & Subject-Oriented
- b) Higher marks in – Govt. of India Rules & Guidelines
- c) Elder candidate (by Date of Birth)
- d) Relevant Experience
- e) Alphabetical order of names, if still tied.

**16. Pen Usage:** Use only the pen provided at the examination centre.

**NOTE:** The Admit Cards are being issued shortly. Kindly contact the [estt@ils.res.in](mailto:estt@ils.res.in), if the Admit Card is not received through email by 17th October 2025. If the photograph or signature of the candidate is not available or visible in the Admit Card, such candidates are required to bring two (2) copies of their passport-size photograph and must sign during the document verification process.
